

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES

- OBEY THE INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE BUS DRIVER AND/OR AIDE.
- WHEN BOARDING THE BUS, GO DIRECTLY TO YOUR ASSIGNED SEAT AND STAY IN THAT SEAT UNTIL YOUR STOP.
- NO FIGHTING, SHOUTING OR USE OF PROFANITY.
- NO EATING, DRINKING OR CHEWING GUM ON THE SCHOOL BUS.
- NO SMOKING, VAPING OR USE OF TOBACCO OR ALCOHOL ON THE BUS.
- NO PHOTOS OR VIDEOS ARE ALLOWED TO BE TAKEN ON THE BUS.
- K – 6 STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO HAVE CELL PHONES OUT ON THE BUS.
- OBSERVE ALL CLASSROOM RULES WHILE ON THE BUS.
- KEEP AISLES CLEAR. ALL BELONGINGS MUST FIT IN YOUR SEAT OR ON YOUR LAP.
- NEVER THROW ANYTHING INSIDE THE BUS OR OUT THE BUS WINDOWS.
- DO NOT STICK ITEMS OR BODY PARTS OUTSIDE THE WINDOWS.
- IF YOU NEED TO CROSS THE STREET, ALWAYS WAIT FOR THE DRIVER TO SIGNAL THAT IT IS SAFE TO CROSS. ALWAYS CROSS IN FRONT OF THE BUS.
- ALL TRASH SHOULD BE PUT IN THE TRASH CAN AND NOT ON THE FLOOR.
- LINE UP AT THE BUS STOP WITHOUT PUSHING OR OTHER HORSEPLAY.
- STAND AT LEAST 10 FEET BACK FROM THE ROAD UNTIL THE BUS DRIVER STOPS AND SIGNALS IT IS SAFE TO BOARD THE BUS. NEVER RUN TOWARDS THE BUS WHILE IT IS MOVING.
- STAY OUT OF THE SCHOOL BUS DANGER ZONE. (THE AREA 10 FEET ALL AROUND THE BUS)
- USE THE HANDRAILS TO GET ON AND OFF THE BUS.
- WAIT UNTIL THE BUS COMES TO A COMPLETE STOP BEFORE STANDING UP TO EXIT THE BUS.
